

Naresuan University Announcement on On-Campus Housing Fee

In order to properly arrange on-campus housing (NU Niwet 1-12 and 14-15) for Naresuan University personnel, the university – set forth by measure 17 and measure 20 of the Naresuan University Act 2010, the clause in item 4 of the Naresuan University Regulation on On-Campus Housing 2011, and the resolution of the University Administrative Committee on November 4, 2015 (22nd/2015) – has agreed upon the enforcement of the On-Campus Housing Fee as described below:

- 1. This announcement is entitled 'Naresuan University Announcement on On-Campus Housing Fee.'
- 2. The announcement is enforced on January 1, 2016
- 3. The below announcements and resolution are to be revoked:
 - Naresuan University Announcement on 'On-Campus Housing Fee for Wityaniwet 1, NU Niwet 1-4' signed on October 16, 2001
 - Resolution of the University Administrative Committee (15th/2002) on 'Fee Adjustments for NU Niwet 1-4 and 5-6' signed on June 5, 2002
 - Naresuan University Announcement on 'On-Campus Housing and Electricity Fee for Naresuan University Senior Administrative Members and Specialist Lecturers' signed on October 5, 2004
 - Naresuan University Announcement on 'On-Campus Housing Fee for NU Niwet 7-8' signed on March 23, 2007
 - Naresuan University Announcement on 'On-Campus Housing Fee' on June 7, 2010

4. Definition of Terms:

'Housing' refers to a residence (large size and small size) that is under administration of the university.

'Personnel' refers to lecturers, government officials, permanent employees, university staff members, specialist lecturers, overseas specialist lecturers, and temporarily employed staff who have worked for the university for more than 3 years.

'Occupant' refers to university staff members who apply for on-campus housing to the Housing Board of the University and are approved for such request.

Rates of on-campus dormitory are indicated below:

- Daily rate for a reception room at NU Niwet 5-7 and 9 is 300 THB, which includes electricity fee.
- Electricity rate for both the conventional room and reception room is charged based upon its actual use as shown in the ampere meter in each room. There is a meter maintenance fee of 20 THB per month.
- Should there be any incurred cost for room maintenance and its amenities, they will be the responsibility of the occupant.
- An occupant who checks out of the room before the 15th of the month will pay half the fee; full rate of the fee will be applied for him/her who checks out after the 15th of the month.
- 7. The fee and other actual costs will be deducted from the salary of the occupant from the month of checking in. If that payroll deduction fails, the occupant is required to pay the fee before the 5th of the next month at the Division of Finance.
- 8. If for any reason the occupant no longer has the right to stay in university housing, the occupant is required to move all personal properties out of the room in no later than 15 days; a 200 THB fine/day will be applied for late moving.
- If that there is an issue which is not covered in this announcement, Naresuan University Regulation on On-Campus Housing 2011 will supersede. Should there be any dispute arising from this announcement, the decision of the president will prevail.
